

# Charted Instructions for Viennese Horseshoe

Kristmen's Design Studio  
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Stitch multiple of 20 + 2  
28 pattern rows

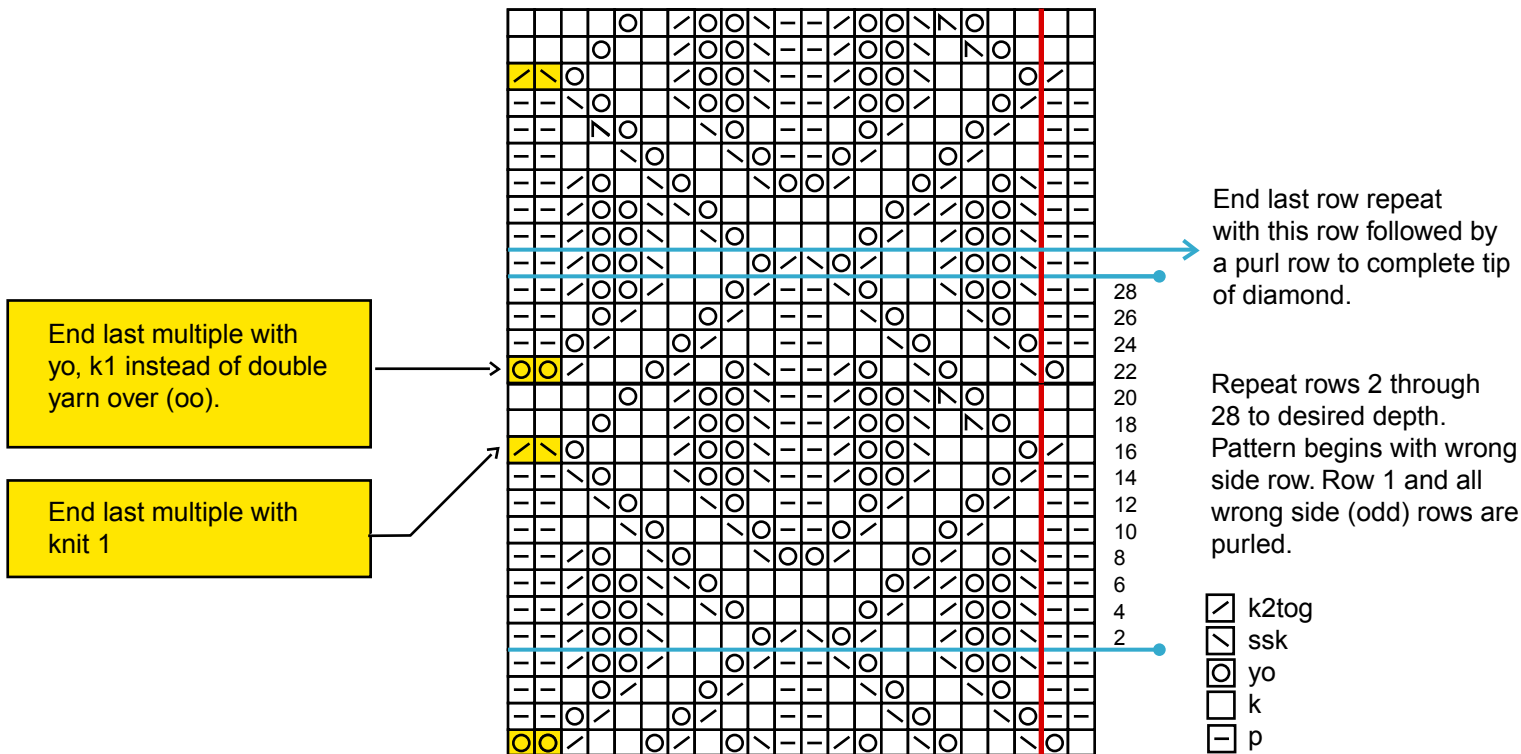

Some general guidelines:

This pattern has a stitch multiple of 20 + 2, and 28 rows. End stitch repeats as indicated to the left of the graph on the rows indicated. These are the only differences from what is done with each multiple.

In the second treasury the pattern begins at the bottom of the chart. I have chosen to move up higher in the chart, where I can start and end essentially at the beginning or middle of a diamond. I have charted out 2 full repeats of the pattern rows in order to more clearly show the pattern. The original row repeats are indicated by the bold black lines. I have used blue lines to indicate where I have chosen to start and finish the 28 row repeat.

**Purl row 1 and all odd (wrong side) rows. These rows are not included in the chart.**



Stitch pattern repeat is 20 + 2
